

# Tips From WynterWolf Photo

## On Making the Most of Your Photo Session~~

1. Several outfits that highlight your personality
  - a. Bring accessories that match and accent outfits
  - b. Solid colors & long sleeves tend to photograph best – however there are always exceptions to this rule.
  - c. The most important thing is to bring clothes you feel good in and things that you find fun!
  - d. Have a variety of both formal and casual
  - e. Bring a variety of colors
  - f. Bring outfits on hangers to avoid wrinkles
  - g. Ensure bras and panties will work with all outfits. If not bring extras of each
  
2. Bring things that are important to you and/or represent activities you do
  - a. Any musical instruments
  - b. Uniforms and/or Letterman jackets
  - c. Things from a hobby you enjoy
  - d. Sports equipment
  - e. Trophies
  - f. Anything that helps you personalize your session
  
3. Touch up accessories
  - a. Hair brush and hair accessories to touch up as you change outfits
  - b. Any makeup to touch up as needed
  
4. Bring your own ideas – this is your photo shoot you are welcome to suggest poses and so forth
  - a. if there are poses you have seen in a magazine or web site that you like bring it to the shoot and we will see what we can do to at least get the feel of the shot.
  
5. Miscellaneous thoughts
  - a. Ensure any nail polish will work w/all outfits –
  - b. Get a good night sleep before the shoot. Being well rested is essential to a good shoot
  - c. Family and friends are welcome to come along and assist you with your session
